YOUNG LEADERS

Our Young Leaders project has been a great success in it's first year. We now have 15 young leaders and many more young people attending their events.

Most recently the young leaders supported Ripon Theatre Festival. They visited a theatre production to critique it for the festival, helped plan a drama workshop which was attended by around 30 young people. In addition they hosted the opening night of the festival, managing the front of house for the theatre performance of Happy Place, at the Arts Hub in Ripon. Over the holidays they will be volunteering to support Ripon Together Summer Fest at Studley Cricket Ground.



FUNDING SUCCESS

Ripon YMCA are delighted to have been awarded a grant from the The National Lottery Communities Fund, starting in September 2023.

The funding is for three years to support young people in Ripon. It will provide us with the opportunity to deliver our Ripon Youth Matters project, increase our offer and capacity to provide a holistic and extensive range of opportunities for young people aged 11-18 years.

The new funding will enable us to introduce new projects or continue our existing portfolio. To include drop in sessions, targeted work, community training offer, employability workshops and accredited courses, employability drop in, diversional activities and regular term time after school projects.


