We <u>do not</u> provide emergency or temporary accommodation for homeless people or those in crisis. Our office is generally open on Monday to Friday between 9am and 4pm.

Supported Housing

Aiming to support young people from dependence to independence

Normally funded through Housing Benefit our Supported Housing helps young people between the ages of 16 to 35 to develop skills, engage with work, education or training and become independent.

We work on an individual basis to identify aspirations and goals and work with young people to help them move forward.

General Needs Housing

Providing a safe and secure place to live

We charge a General Needs rent with most bills included for 18 to 35 year olds to have a place to stay. They may need somewhere short term after a relationship break-up or want to live independently.

Harrogate Borough Council

The Housing Options team at Harrogate Borough Council have a duty to support all homeless people, or those who may become homeless within 56 days, with support and guidance.

16 to 25 years olds can call the HUB team who work with a range of partners to identify solutions for young people who are at risk of homelessness or vulnerable.
